MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR & EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Another successful busy year has passed. In spite of the fact that Covid continued to have a slight grip on some of our functions, we worked through them and finished 2022 successfully and with great optimism. The pandemic left us with some needs within the community, needs we have never seen before and we were able to address some of those needs. I am proud to say that our staff and our Board of Directors again never missed a beat. It left us with a high level of optimism for 2023.

2022 saw a change in the Executive Director position with the Foundation. We were extremely fortunate to fill that position with Kimberly Lavallee. With a big gap to fill Kim jumped into the role with immediate positive results and within a few months she has built a high level of confidence with the entire Board. We also welcomed Melanie Moran to complete our office staff.

I would like to take this opportunity to identify the person who was the driving force behind the accomplishments that have led to the many successes of the Foundation in the past few years. Mandy Dubois initially set up and structured our Foundation office procedures. She brought to us new fund raising opportunities, she initiated new events including the 150 Women Who Care event and she investigated and implemented new marketing opportunities and much more. At this time, on behalf of the entire Board I would like to thank Mandy and wish her well in her future endeavors.

2023 looks to be another busy and successful year. We will be revisiting our strategic plan this Fall to look for the possible need to update and modernize. We have been and will continue to work with Endow Manitoba with such things as conferences and community foundation engagement sessions. With the recent completion of the community assessment report we will be able to use that information to better understand and be more effective in our efforts.

In 2022, CFPD returned to in person board and committee meetings. We said goodbye to three valued members, Anita Janzen-Gemmell, Jody Fletcher and Lucy Kinnear and welcomed two new members, Cathie McFarlane and Amy Chappellaz.

A total of \$215,950.00 in grants was distributed back to the community. Our 150m Women Who Care event was again held in person and was a huge success and tickets sold out in record time. The 2022 \$10,000 grant recipient was the Family Resource Centre.

Thank you to our donors and many sponsors for your continued support. Without you, we could not do this work.

NEW FUNDS 2022

Drs Peabody & Antonissen Fund

Dr. Debbie Peabody and Dr. Lou Antonissen started and ended their medical careers in Portage la Prairie. Lou practiced Family Medicine and anesthesiology; and Debbie had a busy consultative Pediatric practice at the Portage Clinic.

As a pediatrician, Debbie was acutely aware that poor nutrition and hunger can have a devastating effect on a child's health and ability to learn. Children need a good breakfast in order to succeed in their academic classes, participate in physical activities, and to socialize and thrive in a school environment. When Debbie and Lou were first introduced to the breakfast program at North Memorial School, they quickly realized what a vital service this was to the community. So, when they decided to establish a fund to benefit the pediatric population of Portage la Prairie, they chose the Portage la Prairie School Division Breakfast Programs to be one of the recipients.

Debbie and Lou also wanted to support a program that was accessible to all the citizens in Portage la Prairie in need of food assistance. The Salvation Army and their food bank provides food to individuals and families who are struggling financially and cannot meet their own needs. And so, the Drs. Peabody and Antonissen Fund will also contribute to the Portage la Prairie Salvation Army.



Portage Learning & Literacy Fund

Portage Learning & Literacy Centre (PLLC) has had many long-serving Board and Staff Members over the years, and their Board of Directors recently decided to create a bursary fund to recognize these accomplishments as well as help deserving students & clients of the PLLC achieve their career and life goals through post secondary education as well.



The original idea came when PLLC looked to honour Al Braun, a Board Member who had served 26 years and had always been a true advocate for the centre and for the students and clients accessing their programs. He is a strong believer in education being key to opening up opportunities for individuals, personally and professionally, and its positive effects on society as a whole. This is one of the very principles PLLC was founded on, and continues to this day.

PLLC then looked to the Community Foundation of Portage & District (CFPD) for advice and assistance in creating this bursary. The Portage Learning & Literacy Centre Fund – In Honour of Long-Serving Board & Staff members has now officially been launched and the goal is to grow the fund with CFPD and use the investment income earned each year to fund the bursary. PLLC will manage the bursary, including selecting the recipients, and hopes to annually help at least one of their very deserving students or clients who will be pursuing their goals and taking post-secondary studies that year.

CFPD offers the option for not for profit organizations in our community to create their own endowment fund to help annually fund either their programs, their operations, or like in the case of PLLC, fund a bursary program. All donations given to the endowment fund are eligible for a tax receipt and are invested in perpetuity, to provide annual interest earnings. The Portage Learning & Literacy Centre is now looking for support for their fund to help it grow and provide a good source of income annually for their bursary program.
